- Because of the quiet nature of bird walks, they may not be appropriate for children younger than 10.
- Wear comfortable, sturdy shoes, sunscreen, and a hat. Bring your own water and snacks.

BIRD-A-PALOOZA WALKS

Saturday, September 2 | 7:15 a.m. – about 9:30 a.m. | Dripping Springs Natural Area

Meet at the visitor center at 7:15 a.m. There is a \$5 day use (vehicle) fee at Dripping Springs unless you have an appropriate federal lands pass. Your walk leader is Wayne Treers.

Monday, September 4 | 8 a.m. – about 10:15 a.m. | Mesilla Valley Bosque State Park

Meet at the visitor center at 8 a.m. There is a \$5 day use (vehicle) fee at MVBSP unless you have a state parks annual pass. Your walk leader is Danny Tipton.

Saturday, September 9 | 8 a.m. – about 10:15 a.m. | Sagecrest Park

Sagecrest Park is at Roadrunner and Frontier. Meet at the park entrance on Frontier at 8 a.m. Your walk leader is Jonathan Brooks.
